**Treasurer's Report: Marianne Goodwin**

- Marianne gave a brief summary of our revenues and expenses.

**President's Report: Bill Campbell**

- Bill talked about the upcoming Riverboat Cruise that night indicating that we would have approximately 160 attendees even though the band and cheerleaders would not be in attendance.
- Bill talked about the \$26.5M donation that Hugh F. Culverhouse Jr. recently made to the UA Law School which will be renamed the 'Hugh F. Culverhouse Jr. School of Law at the University of Alabama' in Mr. Culverhouse's honor. He also talked about the monthly Crimson Column which AD Greg Byrne prepares each month. This month he talked about the Crimson Standard which is the Athletics Department's 10-year \$600M capital initiative.
- Bill then talked about a number of UA alumni who had distinguished themselves in business and academia.
- Bill recommended that the Chapter By-Laws be amended to eliminate the position of Vice President. The membership in attendance provided their approval of the amendment with a two-thirds vote.
- Finally, Bill talked about the East TN high school recruiting status. There are currently 93 students admitted to the University from as far south as Sweetwater and as far away as Morristown. Across all of East TN there are approximately 181 students admitted to the University.
