Treasurer's Report: Marianne Goodwin

- Marianne gave a brief summary of our revenues and expenses for 4Q18.

Scholarship Committee Report: Ed Lester

- Ed gave an overview of the ETUA scholarship process which will begin in March upon receipt of the East TN scholarship candidates from the University. It will conclude with the presentation of scholarships at the May banquet.

President's Report: Bill Campbell

- Bill talked about the upcoming officer rotations which will occur in June; specifically, Bob LaRue will become President and Greg Stroud will become Secretary. Also, Gene Chunn assumed the role of Treasurer which occurred at the conclusion of the meeting. Everyone thanked Marianne Goodwin for her 12+ years of outstanding service as Treasurer. In accordance with the chapter By-Laws, there was a unanimous vote of approval from the attendees for all three new officers.
- Bill then talked about the scholarships awarded by the NAA to students attending the University in 2018. Specifically, the NAA provided scholarship assistance to approximately 3,000 high school students amounting to more than \$5M. Also, last September the NAA announced that a total of 34 new endowed scholarships were established in 2018 amounting to \$5.2M.
- Chris Lambert gave an overview of the new NAA building at the University which will be located on the Brice campus.
- Bill talked about a number of alumni who had achieved significant success both nationally and internationally since graduating.
- Finally, Bill talked about the upcoming basketball game between BAMA and the Vols which 22 of our members would be attending. He then concluded the meeting with an overview of the meeting and events schedule for February through June. As the upcoming new President, Bob LaRue will determine the schedule for the remainder of the year.
